I hope everyone had a great Christmas with their families and are ready for the New Year!

This month we will be focusing on getting the course ready to flip the 9's. We will have temporary tee signs installed and different tee


markers. Permanent tee signs and tee markers will be installed when they are completed. Once the leaf cleanup is completed we will be working on removing surface roots, bunker work, tree pruning and removal, and equipment repair.

Please enter and exit bunkers on the lower sides to prevent sand from shifting off the steep slopes. As we enter our wet season watch and avoid all soggy areas and try to use the cart paths when possible. We will rope or put signs in these areas to detour cart traffic. Remember to continue using sand and seed and return your bottles to the pro shop so they can be filled. Repair yours and one more ball mark on the greens. If the weather is cold call the maintenance shop or the pro shop to get a frost update. During a frost delay please ask someone in the pro shop if the practice green is clear of frost before practicing. If you have any questions or comments stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.

Happy 2021 everyone! I hope you enjoyed the holiday season as best you could and were able to stay safe and healthy as well. The year 2020 threw us too many curveballs to remember, so here's to hoping 2021 is a whole lot better!

The weather has been very cooperative so far this winter, which has allowed for the course to remain steady with everyday play. As long as we can keep that pesky snow off the ground, we will continue to get a lot of rounds in with our family and friends. The tournament season is right around

the corner, as we have our first two tournaments scheduled for the early part of February. We will be kicking off the 2021 Tournament Schedule with the **Groundhog Tournament on Saturday, February 6th** followed by the **2-Person Super Bowl Scramble on Sunday, February 7th**. Both events are a great way to ease back into the swing of things and get the season started. With indoor dining in the clubhouse likely to still be limited by tournament time, I will do everything I can to make things work logistically from a tournament and social aspect.

You will notice on your statement that we have started billing for certain annual fees. The statement you just received has your **annual course usage fee (trail fee)** for privately owned carts, as well as the **Men's & Women's annual locker fee**. The following price breakdown and description of these fees are listed below:

Course Usage: The course usage fee is charged to all private cart owners that use their own carts at the club. This annual fee is \$120 plus tax. We charge a daily rate of \$15 for any guest carts brought onto the property.

Men's Locker (annual) \$36.

Women's Locker (annual)
\$24 Large Locker / \$12 Small Locker

The Golf Shop services that we offer on an annual basis; **Range Passes, Cart Care and Club Care** will be billed out over the next couple of months. The range passes will be billed next month and the club care and cart care services will be on the statement you receive in March. **Club Care** is the storage, staging and cleaning of your golf clubs after each use for only **\$112 + tax per year**. **Cart Care** includes staging, cleaning and putting away your cart after

each use. Additionally, we monitor the water level of the batteries on a regular basis and fill the cells as needed. We also clean corrosion off battery terminals and periodically give your cart a nice cleanse. You receive all of this for only **\$148 + tax per year**. Both services are designed to make your life easier and to let us handle the dirty work, so please consider signing up for these services if you haven't already. If you like to practice or just warm up before your round then the range pass is a no brainer. The range pass provides unlimited use of range balls while the range is open and **our pass prices are STILL the best in town**. You get a good bang for your buck considering a season range pass costs less than one small range bucket a week. The pricing of the passes are as follows; **Single \$195 + tax, Double \$260 + tax and Family (3 or more) \$325 + tax**. Please let me or one of the golf shop staff know if you want to sign up for any of these programs. If you had a range pass or cart/club care in 2020 and did not notify me that you do not want to renew, I've assumed that you wish to continue for 2021.

All of us in the golf shop want to say thank you once again to the membership for their continued support and patience over the past year. I look forward to having a great golf season in 2021... see you at the club soon!
