

GOLF COURSE UPDATE

The extended forecast is predicting average temperatures and above normal precipitation for May. June, July and August are predicted to be very warm with below normal precipitation. Those of you who enjoy the warmer temperatures it's just around the corner.

We are in the middle of our spring herbicide applications right now. Our goal is to have the entire course treated by the middle of May, if the weather allows. In the last newsletter I mentioned the greens would be healed within 2 weeks with this type of aerification. Well, mother nature had a different plan for the weather than what I was hoping and made a liar out of me. The

cool weather almost put the plant back into a dormant state which will double the healing to the greens. The greens are now beginning to heal and the height of cut is being lowered. This is why it is so important to aerify when the weather is warm and the plant is healthy for a good recovery.

The bathrooms on the front 9 were repainted and spruced up the last few weeks. Tucker and Kolby did a great job! The green side bunker on 2 is being worked on now and should be ready for play soon. We will soon get the bunker on 14 repaired as well.

Remember to keep your carts at least thirty feet from the

putting greens and use the cart paths whenever possible. If you are using a push cart for your bag please remember to keep it off the green. Enter and exit bunkers on the lower sides to prevent sand from shifting off the steep slopes. Sand and seed bottles are at the pro shop. If you have any questions or comments stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.
