

The forecast is predicting warmer than normal temperatures and near normal precipitation rates for July. Schedule your t-times early to beat the heat!

During the heat of the summer we will be focusing on setting sprinklers and hand watering areas that aren't getting adequate water from our irrigation system. We are working on completing the bunker on 14 now and defining all the boundaries of the course. The pool is up and running and the water looks refreshing.



Remember to keep your carts at least thirty feet from the putting greens and use the cart paths whenever possible. If you are using a push cart for your bag please remember to keep it off the green. Enter and exit bunkers on the lower sides to prevent sand from shifting off the steep slopes. Sand and seed bottles are at the pro shop. If you have any

questions or comments stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.

During the hot weather make sure to stay well hydrated.

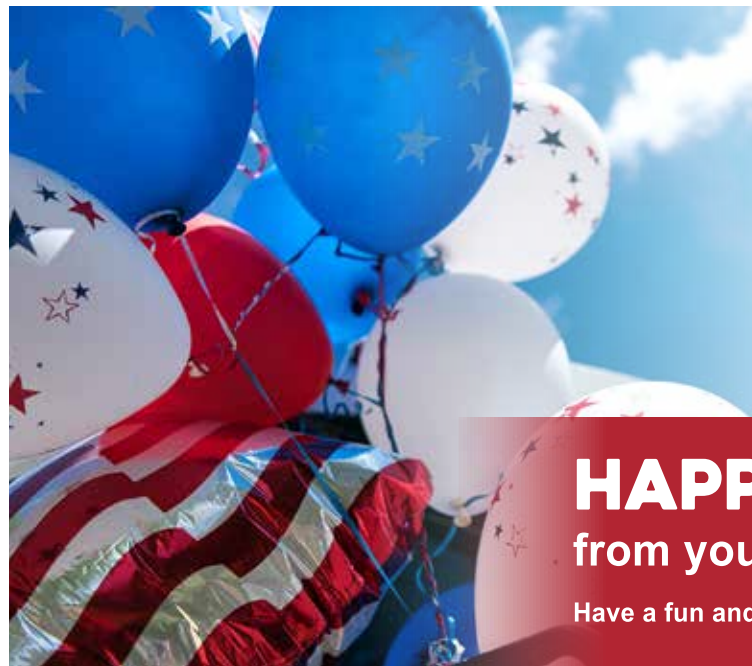
