The forecast is predicting above average temperatures and precipitation for August. With the warm August weather make your tee times early to beat the heat and stay well hydrated.

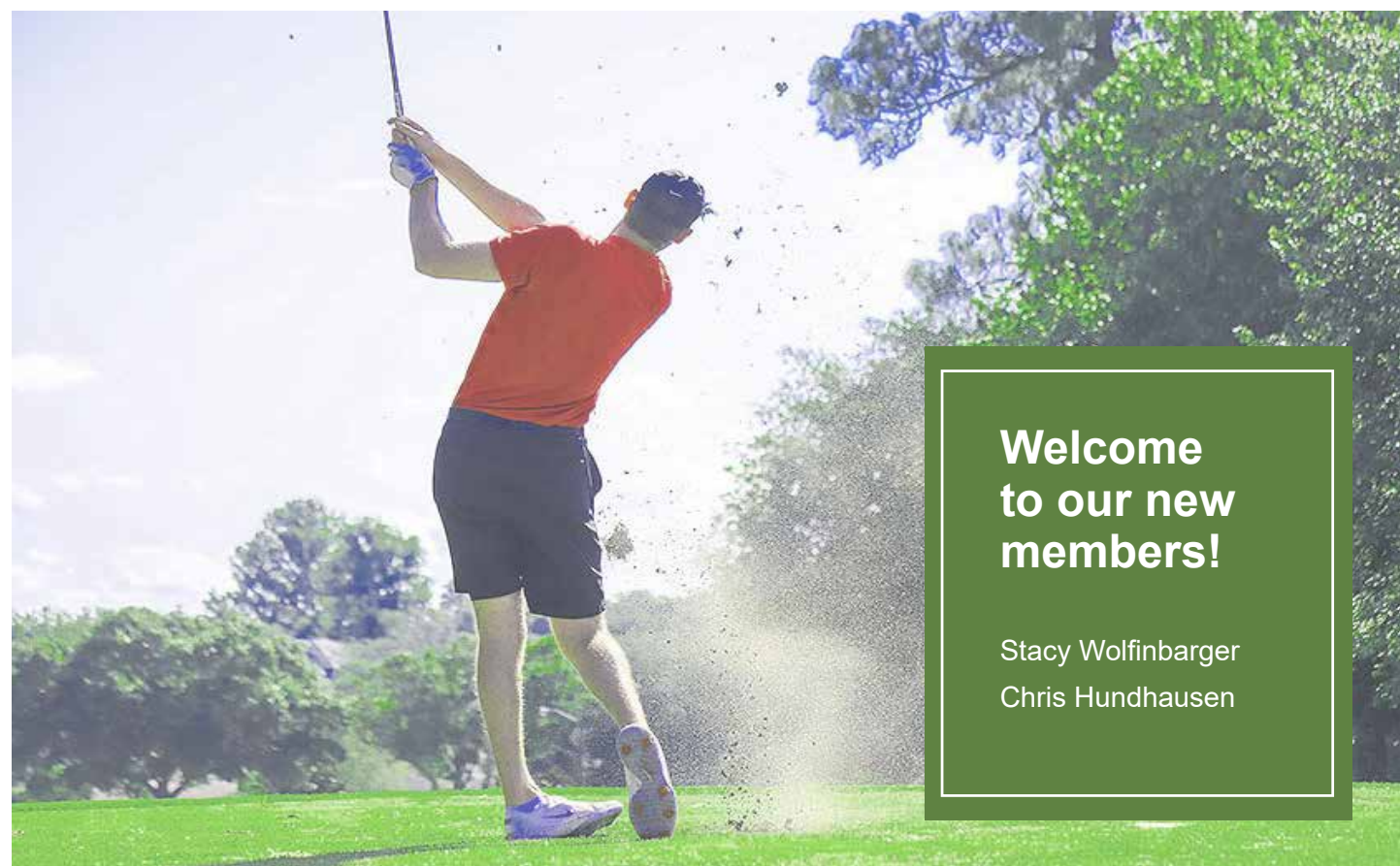
We will continue dragging hoses to help add water to the needed

areas around the course this month. Our goal is to minimize dry areas and wet areas as much as possible. With the shorter days we are reducing our irrigation times to help avoid excessive wet areas. With the type of irrigation system we have we will have wet areas and dry areas but if we can keep them to a minimum and not loose turf we will be doing well.

Remember to keep your carts at least thirty feet from the putting greens and use the cart paths whenever possible. Enter and

exit bunkers on the lower sides to prevent sand from shifting off the steep slopes. Sand and seed bottles are at the pro shop. If you have any questions or comments stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility. Remember, during the hot weather make sure to stay well hydrated.
