Our swimming pool will stay open into the fall during the

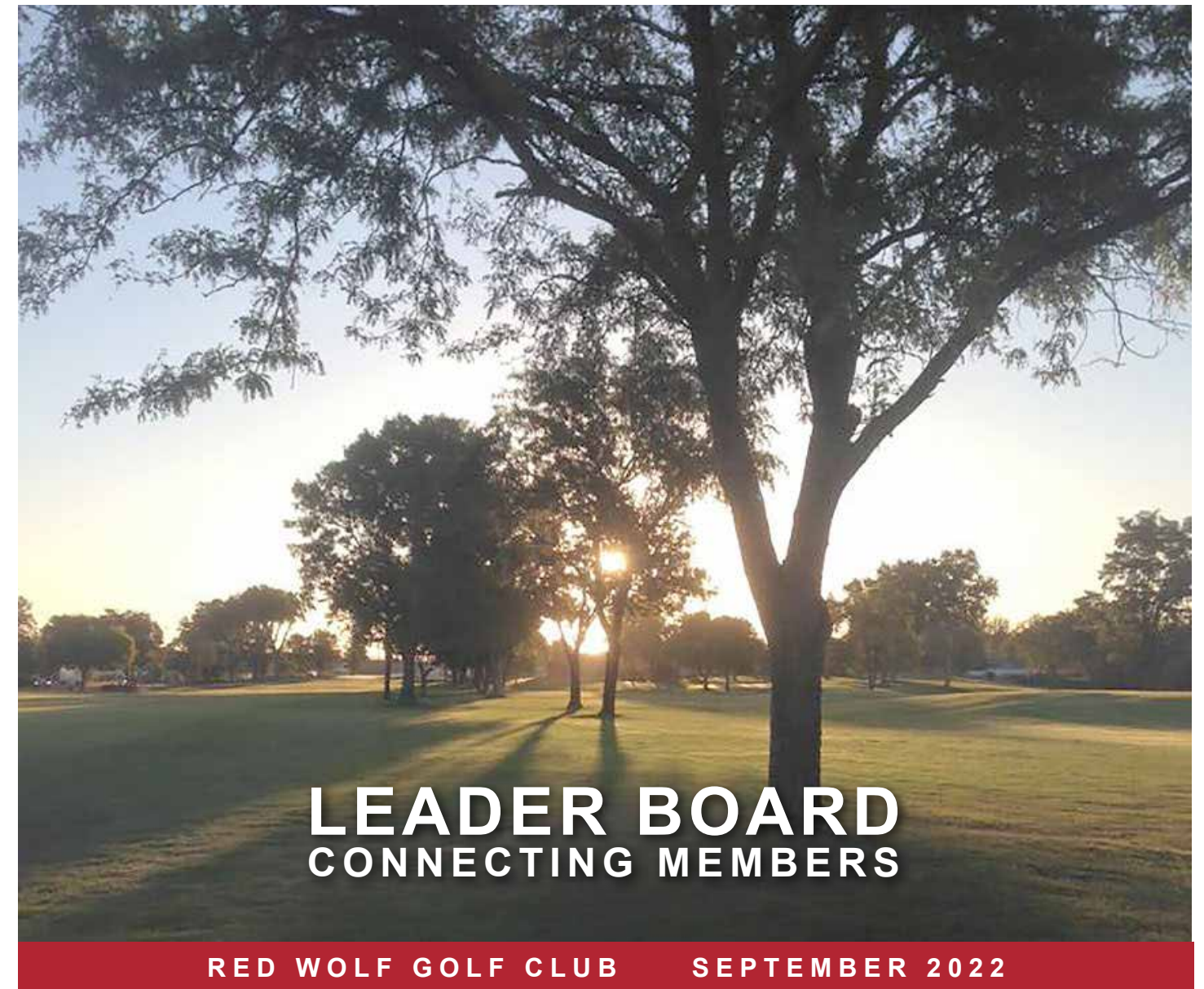

Aerification is just around the corner. We will be aerifying the greens September 6th and 7th. We will be pulling cores and filling the holes with sand and seed. The greens will recover quick with the good weather. Soon as the weather cools the deciduous trees will show off their colors and soon begin to blanket the course. We will be

blowing and chopping the leaves to keep the course playable.

Remember to keep your carts at least thirty feet from the putting greens and use the cart paths whenever possible. Enter and exit bunkers on the lower sides to prevent sand from shifting off the steep slopes. Sand and seed bottles are at the pro shop. If you have any questions or comments stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.
