We have been fortunate so far not to have many frost delays but they're coming. The pro shop will be informed on delays or you can call the maintenance shop. The extended forecast is looking good for those who enjoy the snow in the higher elevations. During the winter months please avoid areas that will damage the turf and scatter your cart traffic to avoid wear patterns.

This month we will be working on winterizing the course. All the ball washers will be brought in except 1,5,10,16. Right now we are grinding all the stumps and

reseeding them. A special thanks to Randy and Margaret Hair for helping with this project. This fall we have had spectacular views of all the deciduous trees showing off their colors. Now these trees are dropping their leaves which makes it difficult to find a ball. We will try to keep the playable areas clean.

Remember to fill your divots with sand and seed, repair your ball mark and one more while waiting your turn to putt. Sand and seed is available at the pro shop. Please return your sand and seed bottle at the end of your round, empty or full, so we can fill them the following morning. Keep your carts 30 feet from putting greens and use your cart paths at all times. If you have any questions or comments stop

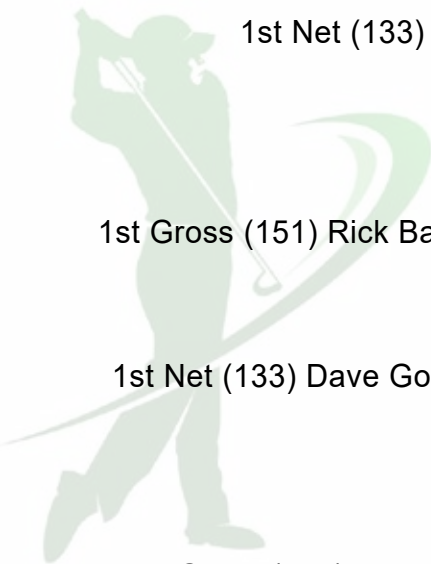

Just a reminder of upcoming charges on your next bill.

The Washington State Golf Association has raised the handicap fee to \$39.00 for the upcoming "2023" season. If you are a member of either the Men's or Women's Associations the billing is going to be separate from the handicap billing, meaning there will be two separate charges.

Women's Handicap \$39.00 and Women's Association \$22.00 = Total \$61.00
Men's Handicap \$39.00 and Men's Association \$71.00 = Total \$110.00
