Every winter is unique in how the golf course handles the stress of the cold weather. This year, because of the moderate, wet conditions and only one week of snow cover, we saw a slight increase in winter disease on the tee boxes and fairways. All of these spots are being taken care of and

will clear up as the temperatures increase. The greens remained in wonderful condition throughout the entire winter and we should see the speed and smoothness continue to improve throughout this month. We are planning to aerify the tee boxes to help prepare them for the upcoming season. This process will not disrupt golf course play at all.

March is a busy, but very exciting month for us.

We hope to see you out enjoying a round of golf, and making a bunch of birdies. We ask that you keep carts on the cart path when around the greens to limit compaction and matting down of grass, and remember to fix ball marks on the greens and fill divots with sand and seed. If the weather is cold call the pro shop or the maintenance shop to get a frost update. If you have any questions or comments don't hesitate to stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.


