

GOLF COURSE UPDATE



Everybody loves to see the grass turn green. It finally feels like spring is here. The maintenance crew is busy at work cleaning up from the cold winter, and have already started mowing. April is a very busy month for our crew and we are excited for the transition to lush, velvety fairways and smooth, fast greens.

Last month our focus on the maintenance crew was tree pruning. We are developing yearly pruning program to keep our trees healthy, safe, and enhance the playability of the golf course. Our goal is to keep the challenging aspect that is the heart of Red Wolf Golf Club while also making it a more enjoyable round for all golfers. This year our focus was to remove all the hanging branches from previous wind storms as well as focus on cleaning up the overgrown trees around #7's green.

Aerification will take place April 10th and 11th. We understand that

this is a frustrating, but essential step in keeping our course healthy and beautiful. The roots of the grass need air as much as we do. Punching holes will allow the roots to breathe and allow water to soak down into the soil which will result in firmer, healthier greens through the stressful summer heat. We are very thankful for your patience and understanding during this process.

We ask that you keep carts on the cart path when around the greens to limit compaction and matting down of grass, and remember to fix ball marks on the greens and fill divots with sand and seed. If you have any questions or comments don't hesitate to stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.

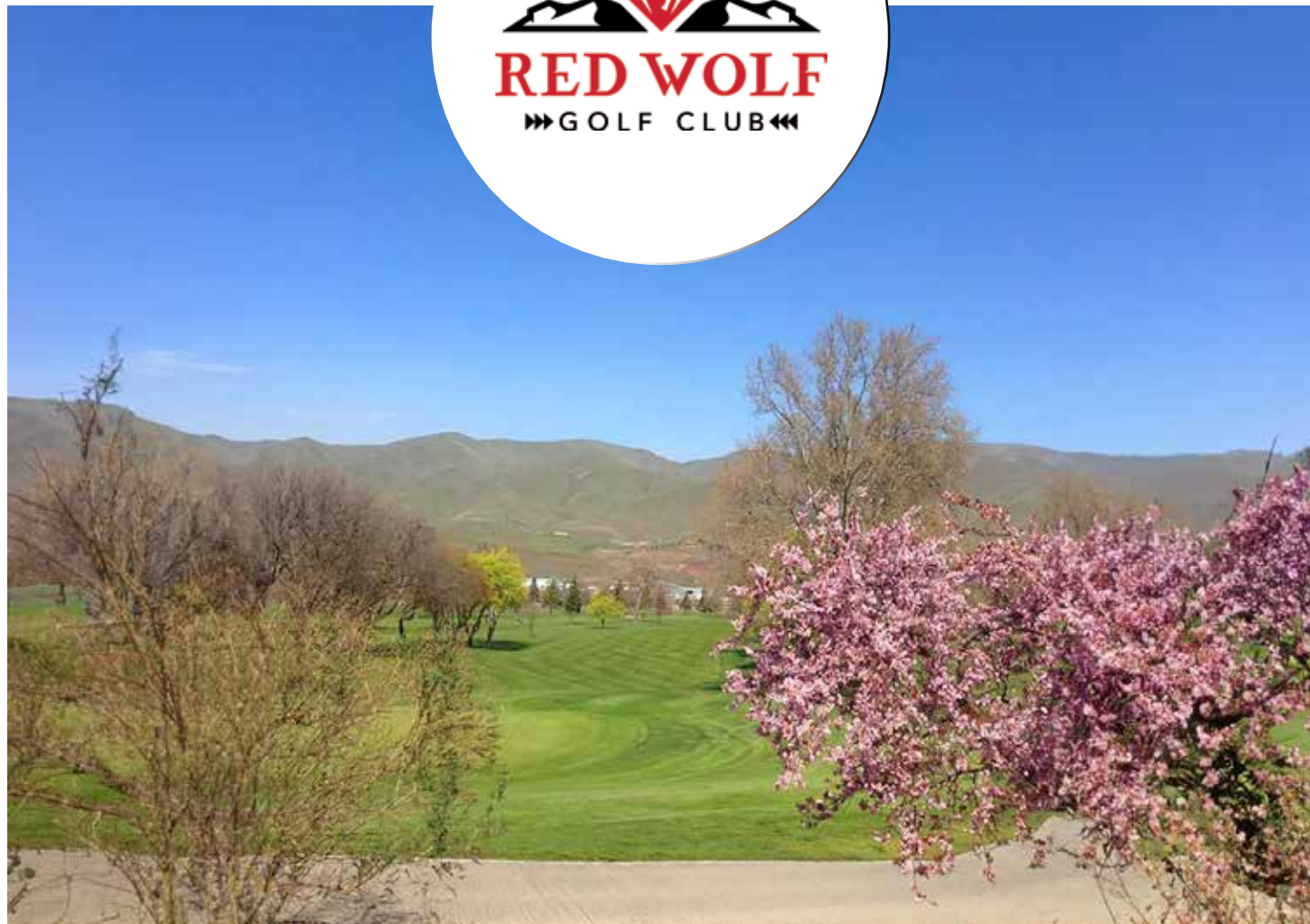
