The clay tennis court is also up and running if you are looking for some fun exercise.

This month is going to be a warm one. Our main focus on the maintenance crew through the next two months will be trying to stay ahead of the heat and keep the grass green. We spent last month getting the new employees trained on all the tasks required to keep the golf course in great shape and I am very excited about how quickly they have learned.

One of my priorities throughout this year has been to develop a program to control the weeds on the golf course. This is a battle we have been fighting since I started working here. Weed management on a golf course can be difficult and requires a lot of care as most weed killers will cause damage to the grass on the greens. Last month we focused our efforts on eliminating weeds from the tee boxes, and the approaches of the greens. Throughout the coming months we will be working on the fairways and the rough around the greens. The process of completely eliminating weeds will take some time as seeds can stay

alive in the soil for multiple years before they decide to grow.

As the amount of play increases throughout the summer, it is very important that golf carts stay on the cart path when around the greens and tees to limit compaction and matting down of grass. Please remember to fix ball marks on the greens and fill divots with sand and seed. We love getting to see the community enjoy our wonderful golf course. If you have any questions or comments don't hesitate to stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.
