

GOLF COURSE UPDATE



The cold weather and frosty mornings are finally here. October gave us a little bit of an extended summer, but it might be time to throw the doors and propane heaters in your golf carts. The leaves are starting to fall in bunches and we have been out cleaning them up as fast as we can.

If you've been out playing you may have seen the work being done on #3's bunker. Over the years sand had piled up on the top edge of the bunker from players hitting shots. After 30 years, the front edge has become foot taller than when it was originally designed. Over the last couple weeks, we have been removing the sod and sand from the front edge to restore the bunker back to its original design. We will also slope the bottom of the bunker

in a way that your ball is less likely to finish up against the front lip of the bunker, and add all new sand.

We have a lot of projects planned for the next couple months. After we finish working on #3's bunker we will do the same type of restoration to the bunker on #8 with the goal of shaping the edges in a way that water does not run off so easily, keeping the grass from getting dry. We will also be working on sprucing up the entrance to the clubhouse and replacing the Red Wolf sign by the practice green that blew over in a wind storm.

We want to remind you that it is very important that golf carts stay on the cart path when around the greens and tees, especially as temperatures get colder, to limit compaction and matting down of grass. Please remember to fix ball marks on the greens and fill divots with sand and seed. We love getting to see the community enjoy our wonderful golf course. If you have any questions or comments don't hesitate to stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.
