Tournament season is just around the corner and the maintenance crew at Red Wolf are excited for this month and to spend more time on the course and see that grass start growing. As we head into March and get closer to the golfing season, we have a lot planned.

One of our focuses through this year will be on our tee boxes. We will be aerifying the tees multiple times throughout the year in order to remove thatch, help with drainage and get some new grass seed into the soil. We will plan this in a way that will have very minimal disruption to play. Our first aerification will take place towards the end of this month. We will be finishing the bunker on hole 3 this month as well. We will start mowing the greens a little more often and as time allows we will roll them as well, so we should see

the greens start to gain some speed and smoothness.

We hope to see you out enjoying a round of golf, and making a bunch of birdies. We ask that you keep carts on the cart path when around the greens to limit compaction and matting down of grass, and remember to fix ball marks on the greens and fill divots with sand and seed. If the weather is cold call the pro shop or the maintenance shop to get a frost update. If you have any questions or comments don't hesitate to stop me on the course or call me at the maintenance facility.
